As of 8 December 2016 - percentage awarded to recipient groups will continue to vary through time.

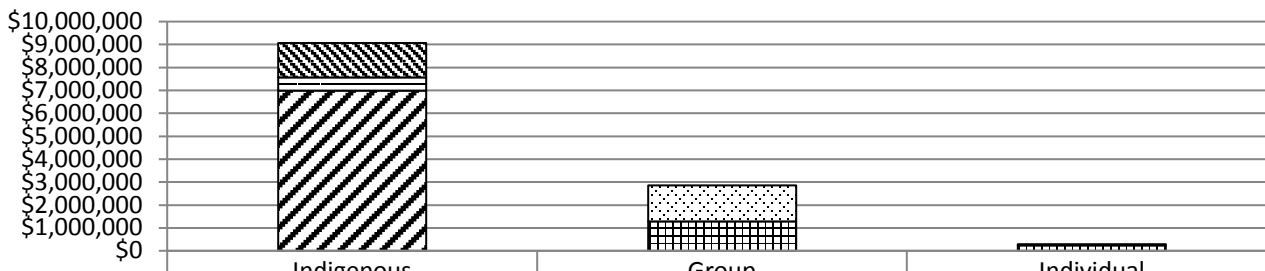
